Build farm management skills and gain a nationally recognised qualification. We offer a blended learning format that is designed to develop farm production and management skills through the combination of study and integrated engagement with industry and practical experiences. Diploma of Agriculture students elect to major in livestock or crop production.

Designed for year 12 school leavers and workers seeking to develop their agricultural management skills, this course will be delivered face to face in Armidale, full time (4 days per week) over 12 months and include a broad range of practical skill development and industry engagement activities.

It is expected that students undertake work experience during their semester break (May/June). This can be on a family farm or other suitable employer.

Graduates of this course are sought after for management roles across the agricultural sector.

To be eligible for funding under NSW Smart & Skilled you must be:

An Australian Citizen, New Zealand Citizen, permanent resident or humanitarian visa holder, Aged 15 years or older, Not at school (excluding home schooled students), Living or working in NSW.

In addition to the above eligibility criteria, to be eligible for **fee free training** a student must also meet one of the criteria below:

- Be 17-24 years of age, including 2020 Year 12 School Leavers (regardless of employment status); **OR**
- Be unemployed (you DO NOT have to be in receipt of any Commonwealth benefits or registered with Centrelink); **OR**
 - At risk of unemployment (contact us for more info about this crietria)
