There is **NO** student contribution required. Training is offered online – no travel required.

To be eligible, you must be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen. You must also live or work in NSW; be over 15 years of age and have left school. Normal entry requirements apply (refer to our website for details)

- Delivery:** Training is offered online. All materials are available online You will require a computer with at least Windows 7 and a stable internet connection.
- Costs:** No student fees are payable.

1. **Soils** (2 units) – AHCSOL401 Sample soils and interpret results, AHCSOL501 Monitor and manage soils for production projects
2. **Farm Planning** (1 unit) – AHCAGB505 Develop a whole farm plan
3. **Livestock** (3 units) – AHCLSK505 Develop production plans for livestock, AHCLSK504 Develop livestock health and welfare strategies, AHCLSK503 Develop and implement a breeding strategy
4. **Crops** (3 units) – AHCBAC505 Plan & manage long term weed, pest or disease control in crops, AHCBAC507 Develop Production Plans for Crops, AHCBAC508 Apply Plant Biology to Agronomic Practices
5. **Risk Management** (2 units) – AHCBUS608 Manage risk, AHCAGB501 Develop climate risk management strategies
6. **Succession Planning** (1 unit) – AHCAGB602 Manage Estate Planning
7. **Workplace health and safety** (1 unit) – AHCWHS401 Maintain work health and safety processes
8. **Farm Record Keeping** (3 units) AHCAGB301 Keep production records for a primary production business, AHCAGB403 Keep financial records for a primary production business, AHCBUS401 Administer finance, insurance and legal requirements
9. **Farm Business Management** (3 units) – AHCBUS506 Develop and Review a Business Plan and AHCBUS507 Monitor and review business performance, AHCBUS508 Prepare and monitor budgets and financial reports
10. **Chemical Card Plus:** AHCCHM303 Prepare and Apply Chemicals; AHCCHM304 Transport, handle and store Chemicals (This is the standard AQF3 chemical accreditation for farmers – is yours up to date?)

Complete the Expression of Interest form over page and return to us with an email explaining why you want to do the training. The funding is available to help improve business productivity, or to gain skills to enter the workforce. Explain how this applies to your particular business (give an example).
